### **Notes:-**

Opposite St James' churchyard, attached (to left) to No 65 Walter Road.

Circa 1865 pair of semi-detached houses.

Three storeys plus attic behind low parapet; stucco, branded to ground floor, tiled roof, gabled dormers, horned sash glazing (but left house has top floor left casement window). Some details of No 67 obscured in conversion to restaurant.

Four bays with central 2 bays slightly advanced articulated by pilasters which run up as acroteria, each bay with, on second floor, paired square-headed windows in architrave; on first floor Venetian window; on ground floor, splayed bay window. End bays have second floor window with architrave; first floor window with architrave and pierced balcony; ground floor has entrance doorway with moulded surround and cornice, door with rectangular overlight.

Part of relatively unspoilt terrace opposite main open space in Walter Road.
