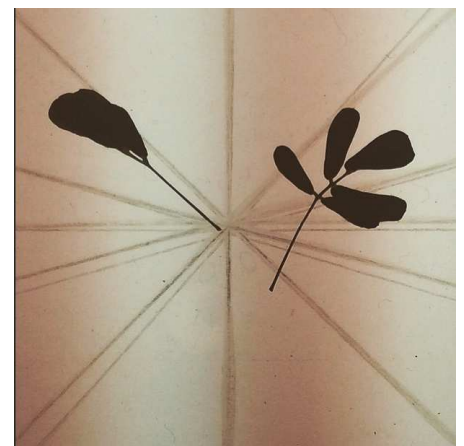
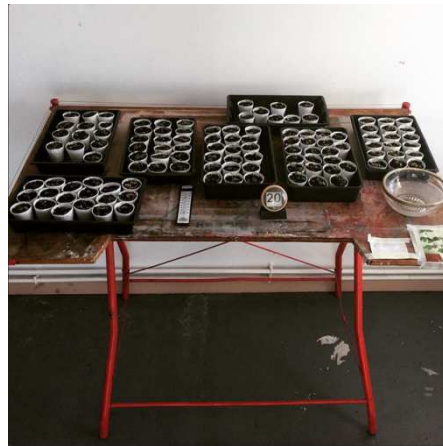


Glynn Vivian Artist in Residence: Jessica Hoad
