### **Notes:-**

Set away from the main road and reached under the railway line. Formerly on west bank of Swansea Canal (now filling in) begun 1794, fully opened 1798.

Late 18<sup>th</sup> to early 19<sup>th</sup> century. Tapering stone rubble wall 5.8 metres square. Discharge opening with segmental brick arch to east side, facing canal; further possible opening in south wall and vertical, full height chase in north wall (to bond in with lateral retaining wall). Copper slag charging bank formerly against west and part of north elevations. One of only three lime-kilns remaining along the Swansea Canal in 1978.

In derelict condition at time of inspection (Spring 1986).
