### **Notes:-**

Set back from the quay wall at west bank of New Cut (1845-51). Reset in modern paved terrace with flagstaff; north bollard lower down and closer to river.

Mid 19<sup>th</sup> Century. One inscribed "Ynisedwyn Iron Works", the notable ironworks at Ystradgynlais. Cast-iron stems, about two feet high, with moulded flat rims and hemispherical caps. Embossed lettering round rim.

Fine pair of a notable type of widely exported bollards.
