Notes:-

On the corner with Princess Way, immediately south of St. Mary's Churchyard.

Dated 1908. Queen Anne Revival.

Two-storey and attic, red brick with Bath stone dressings including banding. Slate roof with ridge stack to right and front stack on splayed angle to left; moulded corbel with elaborate cartouche, diagonal pilasters, volute supports and moulded cornice.

Attic storey behind parapet with stone window frames, five-bay north front with stone cornice to parapet, bowed centre bay with three-light mullioned upper window under cornice, small pane glazing, carved royal arms "ERVII" in ashlar field over arched hood to bowed entrance. Foliage corbels, egg-and-dart cornice, convex architrave, double recessed doors under inscribed tympanum. Side bays with cross windows to upper floor, three-light ground-floor windows, all with cornices, impost bands and moulded cills.

Three-storey two-window elevation to Princess Way with parapetted gable and segmental pediment to capping, smaller corbelled chimney stack to left with carved angel supporter. Two and three-light windows as before, horizontal linkage on top floor. Plainer extension to left with doorway up steps.
