### **Notes:-**

Set into the hillside beside new dual carriageway, tall east end to Neath Road.

c.a. 1903 (date on rainwater heads). Perpendicular style with Arts and Crafts influence. Plan of chancel with undercroft, two storey south-east vestry range with octagonal bell tower in angle, north chapel, aisled nave with north and south porches.

Sneaked facings, red sandstone dressing, slate roofs, gable parapets with ease crucifix finial, corner buttresses with set offs. Five light traceried east window with blind panelling below transom, cill band and weathercourse over three part recessed undercroft window with segmental head. Bell tower has spire with weatherwave behind crenellated parapet, linked ogeeheaded hood moulds to bell openings, arched doorway in pointed recess. Three light clerestory windows under segmental arches, tripartite cusped lancets to aisle, image niche over south door with traceried spandrals, double boarded doors up steps. Three bay front with two light traceried windows and slender buttresses.

Five bay nave with octagonal piers and pointed arcades (rest of interior not seen).
