### **Notes:-**

Forming churchyard between St James' Crescent and Walter Road.

Circa 1867, contemporary with St James' Church.

Dwarf stone wall, snecked with chamfered coping, raised stone piers with triangular coping. Between piers, cast iron posts with pinnacles, and curved stanchions (some posts with inscription, "Thomas and Bath Swansea"), and sections of railings with altering pinnacles and compound double crosier shaped finals (some railings removed to north east of church). Entrances with double cast-iron gates to east and west angles of churchyard, and to North west of church, gates in similar style to railings.
