Location:-

To the north west of Tredegar Fawr house.

History:-

Late 18th century early 19th century farm building combining pigsty with loft over probably serving as hen-house, and dove-loft in gable. Walls of pig-pen lost. The building was restored from dereliction in the 1980's; the roof timbers and lantern-like pigeon entrance are all modern.

Exterior:-

Tall square-plan building in local stone; slate roof with square wooden lantern. Facing east at ground level, two round-headed arches to sty. Facing south, at middle level, camber-headed doorway; oculus in gable.

Interior:-

Brick wall divides lower section between arches; modern roof timbers.

Listed:-

Listed as an extremely unusual farm building combining several uses and for group value.
