Notes:-

Location:-

In woods to south east of Stouthall mansion, close to the private road to the house.

History:-

Probably contemporary with the completion of Stouthall, c. 1790.

Exterior:-

An ice-house in limestone surviving complete with its dome, the top of which has at some time been consolidated or strengthened in concrete. At the west side is a passage in rubble limestone incorporating a bend to the north. The roof of the passage and the original doors are missing.

Interior:-

It is about 3m internal diameter and is said to be about 3m deep below the entrance level. Drains from the bottom of the ice-house have been observed.

Listed:-

A well-preserved late C18 ice house.
