Location:-

Situated on the north side of the farmyard just east of the A483 some 1.7 kilometres south of junction 47 on M4 motorway.

History:-

Early to mid 19th century outbuilding, one of three around the farm courtyard at Bryn-rhos, a Penllergaer estate farm. All originally were whitewashed and had hipped roofs, replaced with gabled roofs in late 19th century probably. This range had cart sheds and stables to ground floor.

Exterior:-

Outbuildings, rubble stone with slate roofs, and openings with stone voussoirs. Two storeys, loft with five windows, one centrally over pair of cart entries to left, the other four over four doors with altered concrete lintels. The second and fourth windows are blank, all have stone voussoirs. The three open windows have boarded doors. Coach entries have square piers between and cambered heads with stone voussoirs. West end wall has outside steps to loft door with stone voussoirs.

Interior:-

Interior is lofted, with collar truss roof retaining structure of former hipped ends. Stable has two big chamfered beams.

Listed:-

Included as part of a little altered 19th century estate farm group, a very rare survival in the region.
