Location:-

Situated approximately 120m E of the junction of Cwm Chapel Road and the B5444.

History:-

Entrance gates, wall and railings to Capel Salem, Calvinistic Methodist Chapel of 1903-1905 by W W Williams of Swansea, who died during the construction, the work being completed by W David of Swansea. Presumably of the same date as the chapel.

Exterior:-

Chapel entrance gates, walls and railings. Two large gate piers in rock faced rubble stone with plinths and ashlar pyramidal Gothic caps with gablet on each face. Ornate double iron gates with scroll work decoration. To each side is coursed sandstone retaining wall with ashlar chamfered coping carrying low railings to similar pattern gates.

Listed:-

Included as a good example of iron work of c1900 and for group value with the chapel.
