

## Notes:

- 1. The Welsh Index of Multiple Deprivation 2019 (WIMD 2019) is the official measure of relative deprivation for small areas in Wales.
- 2. Each domain is based on a range of different indicators, which are weighted and combined to provide domain scores and rankings and the overall index of multiple deprivation. Income and Employment each account for 22% of the total Index score, Health 15%, Education 14%, Access to Services 10%, Housing 7%, and Physical Environment and Community Safety 5% each.
