Between a Rock and a Hard Place

This major solo exhibition will include an exciting range of works by one of Wales's leading contemporary artists.

The exhibition includes *Bridges* (2009), a series of work in which Davies utilises found images of bridges from around the world, erasing all traces of the background to reveal only the structures themselves, and in doing so brings vividly to our attention their real and symbolic meanings.

Also included will be other recent two-dimensional work and video pieces such as *Kilkenny Shift* (2009), a site-responsive work made for Kilkenny Castle in Ireland.

Tim Davies lives and works in Swansea and has exhibited in both the UK and internationally. He was winner of the Mostyn Open Prize in 1997, the National Eisteddfod Fine Art Gold Medal in 2003, the Richard and Rosemary Wakelin Purchase Award in 2005 and was shortlisted for the prestigious Artes Mundi prize in 2004.
